## Article and Book Requests for all NUH staff

Journal articles or books that are not available in the libraries or via Athens can be requested as an inter-library loan.

Requests can be made by email ([library@nuh.nhs.uk](mailto:library@nuh.nhs.uk)), phone (ext. 56787), via the NUH Library Intranet, or at the NUH Library counter.

- **Article requests:** 10 free per calendar year, then £7.50 per article
- **Book requests:** £6 per book or per whole journal issue. Book inter-library loans can also be requested from the Greenfield Medical Library

**Membership:** NUH staff can join the Greenfield Medical Library on the QMC site. To join, take your Trust ID card along to the library.

**What's available?** Access to print journals and books; group and silent study space; relaxed seating areas; PCs for NUH staff; and the Walk-in User Service which provides access to a wide range of e-resources at a dedicated computer within the library.

**Where can I return books?** At the Greenfield Medical Library, the NUH Library, or in the book box on North Corridor at City Hospital.

**Library Catalogue:** <http://nuhlibrary.cirqahosting.com>

**Opening hours:** Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

**Who can use the library?** All NUH staff, University of Nottingham staff and students, students on placement within the Trust, and GP trainees. To join, take your staff/student ID along to the library.

**What is available?** Quiet and group study areas; print journals and books; CDs; PCs; video/DVD player; fiction collection; relaxed seating areas; photocopying, printing, scanning and laminating.

**How many items may I borrow?** A maximum of 6 items

**How long for?** Books: either 28 or 7 days. Journals: 7 days (excluding current issues), no renewals. CDs: 7 days

**Interest Areas/New Stock:** If you want to be notified about new books of specific interest to you, we can add your areas of interest to your account. You will receive an e-mail when new books are available.

**Fines: 10p per day** for a 28 day loan **40p per day** for 7 day loans.

Loans and renewals are not permitted if fines reach £2.

Readers are responsible for any items borrowed and failure to return them may result in replacement charges.

**Where can I return books?** At the NUH Library, the Greenfield Medical Library or in the book box on North Corridor at City Hospital.

**Renewing books:** Books can be renewed by phone or via the library catalogue. They may be renewed twice, unless they are reserved by another reader, or if you have fines of £2 or more. You will need your library card number.

**Reservations:** If an item is on loan, we can reserve it for you or you can reserve it via the library catalogue (you will need your library card number).
